UKFP 2022 Allocation Results

The table below provides the number and percentage of applicants included in the national allocation who selected each foundation school as their first preference (“1st pref”), the number of applicants allocated to places who did not rank the school as their first preference (“not-1st pref”), the number and percentage of applicants who were pre-allocated based on personal circumstances (PAs), and the lowest scores for allocated applicants by foundation school (excluding and including those pre-allocated). This table includes FP applicants not withdrawn at the time of the national allocation. Applicants who accepted an SFP/FPP offer earlier in the process are not included.

The UKFPO allocated all reserve list applicants as soon as notifications of vacant posts were received due to primary list applicant withdrawals, failed medical school finals and the creation of additional places.
