What is the F2 Stand-alone Programme SJT?

The Situational Judgement Test (SJT) is a computer-based assessment, which has been designed to assess some of the essential competences outlined in the F2 standalone Person Specification and is based around clinical scenarios.

The SJT assesses the following attributes including professional integrity, team collaboration, empathy and compassion, and adaptability.

The SJT presents applicants with a series of work-related situations and asks them questions about how they would respond to these situations. These questions are rating format.

Who needs to take the F2 Stand-alone Programme SJT?

All applicants to the F2-Standalone Programme need to sit this SJT.

What is the format of the F2 Stand-alone Programme SJT and how many questions will there be?

<u>NDA</u>

A non-disclosure agreement which you must accept in order to progress to the actual test

Untimed

Tutorial (10 mins)

An optional tutorial to help you understand the basic functionality of the computer-based test and how to navigate through it and select your responses

SJT section 1 (45 mins)

20 scenarios (all rating scenarios), each with several questions to respond to

Survey (5 mins)

An optional survey to enable you to give feedback
