

## **What is the F2 Stand-alone Programme SJT?**

The Situational Judgement Test (SJT) is a computer-based assessment, which has been designed to assess some of the essential competences outlined in the F2 stand-alone Person Specification and is based around clinical scenarios.

The SJT assesses the following attributes including professional integrity, team collaboration, empathy and compassion, and adaptability.

The SJT presents applicants with a series of work-related situations and asks them questions about how they would respond to these situations. These questions are rating format.

## **Who needs to take the F2 Stand-alone Programme SJT?**

All applicants to the F2-Standalone Programme need to sit this SJT.

## **What is the format of the F2 Stand-alone Programme SJT and how many questions will there be?**

### NDA

A non-disclosure agreement which you must accept in order to progress to the actual test

Untimed

### Tutorial (10 mins)

An optional tutorial to help you understand the basic functionality of the computer-based test and how to navigate through it and select your responses

### SJT section 1 (45 mins)

20 scenarios (all rating scenarios), each with several questions to respond to

### Survey (5 mins)

An optional survey to enable you to give feedback
