

F2 Person Specification

All applications for the F2 Stand-alone programme will be longlisted in accordance with the national person specification for F2 programmes. Some of the criteria will also be considered during the interview.

Applicants are advised to familiarise themselves with the complete applicant guidance document to ensure they meet the requirements of the person specification at the relevant milestones in the application process.
