# Allocation Update - June 2021

#### **Purpose**

This document provides information about the allocation of applicants who were placed on the reserve list for the 2021 Foundation Programme following the primary list allocation.

All applicants on the reserve list have now been allocated a foundation training place. This document describes the process and confirms the number of applicants allocated this month.

### **Summary**

The primary list allocation to foundation school results were released shortly after midnight on Thursday 11 March 2021. A total of 7081 foundation training places (AFP, FPP and FP) were filled and 494 applicants were placed on the reserve list.

Applicants on the primary list were allocated to foundation programmes on 8 April 2021. Some applicants have since withdrawn from the Foundation Programme. At the end of April 2021 there were 60 unfilled foundation training places across the programme and a total of 484 applicants remained on the reserve list. 140 additional training places were identified in May 2021, as well as further vacancies due to applicant withdrawals. 219 applicants on the reserve list were allocated to foundation school on Thursday 20 May 2021.

Following this, 150 additional training places were identified in June 2021, as well as further vacancies due to applicant withdrawals. The 249 applicants remaining on the reserve list were allocated to foundation school on Thursday 10 June 2021.

Of the 249 applicants who were allocated to foundation training places across the UK, 150 were UK nominees and 99 were Eligibility Office applicants.

No further applicants remain on the reserve list and the national allocation process for UKFP 2021 is now complete.
