

UK Foundation Programme (UKFP) 2022

Allocation Update – April 2022

Purpose

This document provides information about the allocation of applicants who were placed on the reserve list for the 2022 Foundation Programme following the primary list allocation.

All applicants on the reserve list will be allocated a foundation training place. This document describes the process and outcome of the process so far.

Summary

The primary list allocation to foundation school results were released on Thursday 10 March 2022. A total of 8,209 foundation training places were filled (this includes additional posts created for FP2022) and 791 applicants were placed on a reserve list.

UKFPO listened to feedback received in previous years on the management of the reserve list. We recognise that it can be a very anxious time for applicants and so this year we changed the process of allocation for reserve list applicants, so that they would be allocated to a Foundation School much sooner. We are pleased to confirm that on Thursday 21 April 2022, all 787 (390 UK nominees and 397 Eligibility Office applicants) applicants remaining on the reserve list, were allocated to a foundation school.

Pre-allocation based on personal circumstances

UKFPO have a pre-allocation process for those need to be placed within a geographical area for specific reasons. We can confirm that all applicants (56 in total) with approved pre-allocation status on the reserve list, were placed at the desired Foundation School.

Programme Allocation Process

Applicants' allocated foundation schools will manage the programme allocation process. Foundation schools will contact applicants on their local reserve list directly to let them know about the local process and timescale for matching to specific programmes.
